Assistance and support from Brennan Equine Welfare Fund have helped horses like "Camilla", who was rescued from neglect in Miami, Florida. As part of a seizure of 12 horses by the SPCA and the Dade County Sheriffs Office, she was in a severe emaciated state and considered unadoptable. In her 30's, she now resides in permanent retirement at Retirement Home For Horses, thanks to a grant that helps sponsor her care.

Grant Review Process In Full Swing

Many grant requests have been received during the submittal period of January 1-April 30. The review process is continuing and selections will be made soon.
